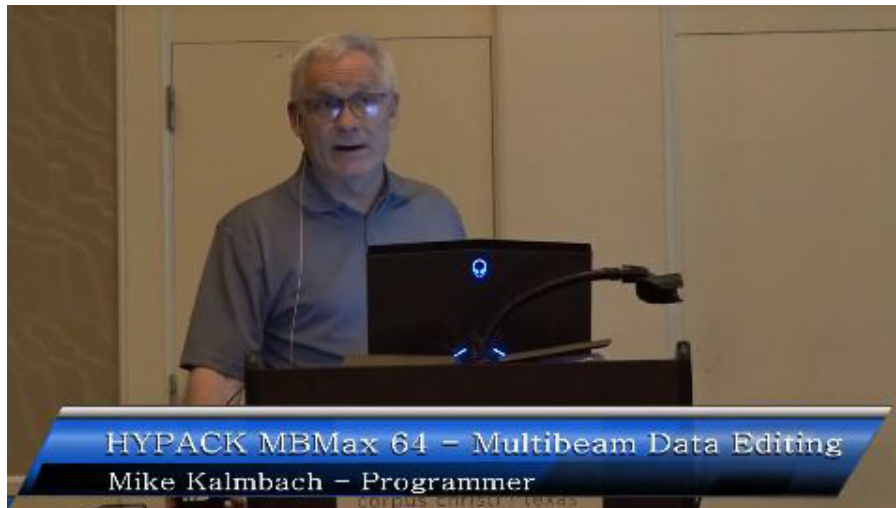
The HYPACK 2019 Training Event was held January 9-11, 2019 at the Omni Corpus Christi Hotel. Over 250 attendees were treated to 40-plus hours of seminars during the three days of training on the Gulf of Mexico. The exhibit hall was packed with hydrographic industry manufacturers, providing a meeting point for HYPACK® users and the cutting edge hardware that HYPACK® supports.

HYPACK Customer Support Manager, Jerry Knisley, welcomed all HYPACK 2019 attendees to Corpus Christi on Wednesday morning. His “What’s New in HYPACK 2019?” session featured an introduction to the latest and greatest updates from our soon-to-be-released HYPACK® 2019 software.



Once again, the Welcome/What’s New session and other training seminars in the Main Ballroom were recorded for archived viewing, as were 15 more sessions from the smaller breakout rooms. HYPACK Support Technician Joe Burnett spoke about Multibeam Data Collection using HYPACK®/HYSWEEP®, as well as LIDAR Data Processing with MBMax64, and Multibeam Tips and Tricks.



There were also Side Scan and Magnetometer Data Collection and Editing sessions with HYPACK Programmer Daniel Tobin, and the first ever HYPACK Training Event Question and Answer Session with our own panel of experts. The smaller breakout rooms focused on DREDGEPACK® Operations and Reports, Single Beam survey and editing tools, TIN MODEL, Volumes, the use of HYPACK® on Autonomous Vehicles and Drones, HYPACK® Final Products, and much more.
