

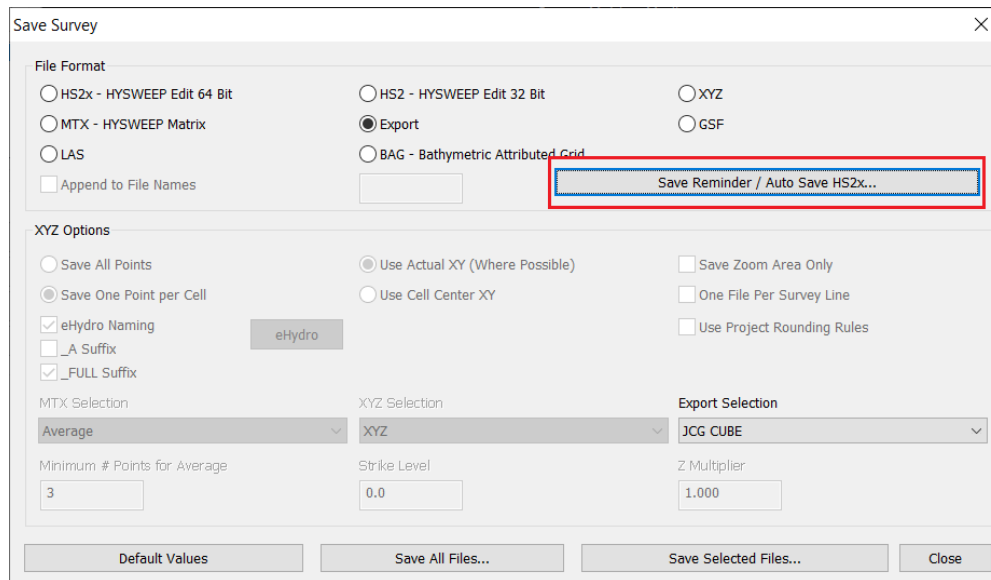


MBMAX64 - File Save Timer

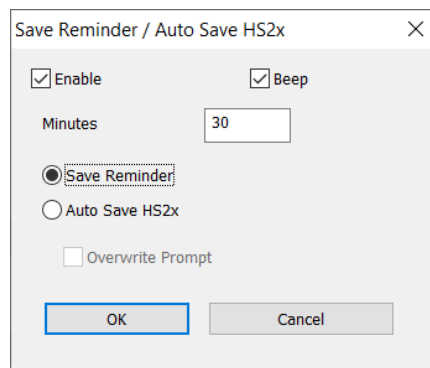

In MBMAX64, we've added a timer you can use to remind you to save or automatically save edits and changes. The reminder feature was introduced last year, auto save in the third quarter HYPACK® 2022 update. Here's how to use the timer.

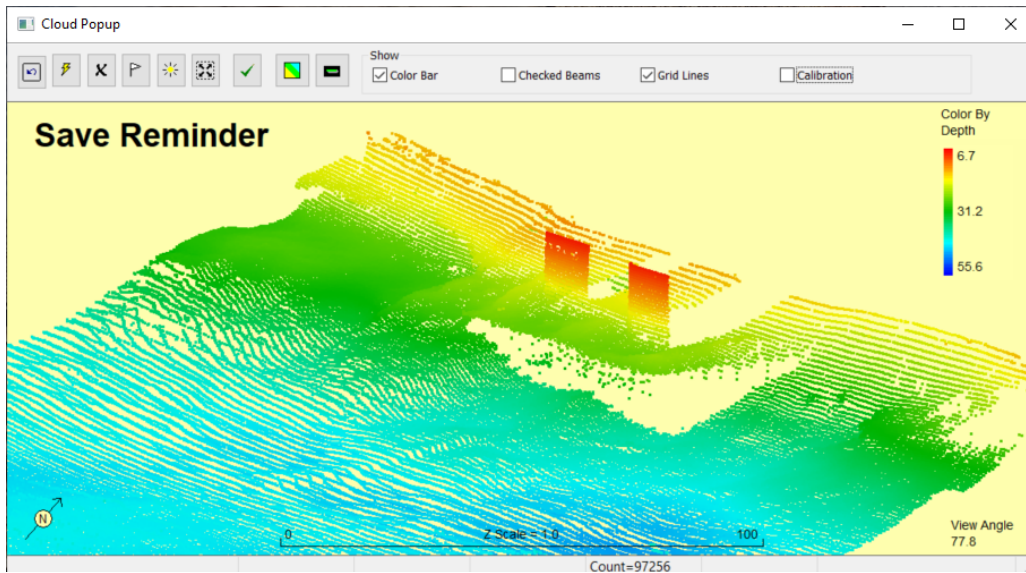
To set up Auto Save, in MBMAX64, click File -> Save Survey, then click [Save Reminder / Auto Save HS2x...].



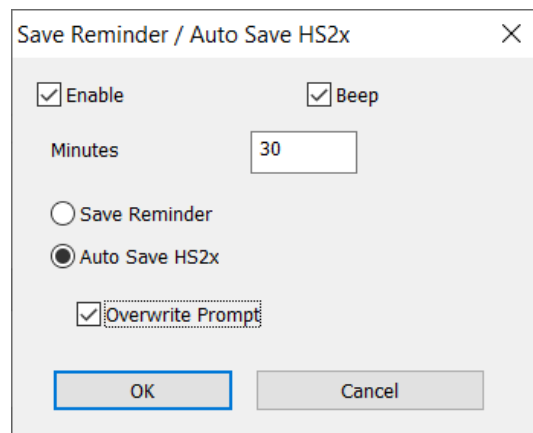
Enable the timer by checking the box next to Enable, select Beep if you want an auditory notification. In the Minutes box, enter the time interval at which you want your files to be autosaved or be reminded to save them. This value must be an integer of 1 or greater. For the reminder, click the Save Reminder button and [OK].



It's quite obvious when the timer expires as edit windows change to an unnatural color. At this point it's up to the user to save changes. You've been reminded!



To use the auto save option, click Auto Save HS2x. Check or uncheck Overwrite Prompt, then [OK].



This option goes about its business quietly. You will get an over write prompt that says “File Already Exists. Overwrite?” if that option is selected and HS2x files already exist. That’s it.

A note regarding both of these options - the timer doesn't start until something needs saving.

A note regarding Auto Save HS2x - it only works with files that can be saved to HS2x. For example, this won't help with saving XYZ files.
